EXPECTATIONS WITHIN THE YOUTH MINISTRY:

- a) To PRIORITIZE Tuesday Nights for Youth (This would include clearing and keeping your schedule open to accommodate)
 - Arrive at 6:30 for Leader Prayer and Instructions (unless otherwise i. communicated)
 - Remain until 9:30 for cleanup (unless otherwise communicated)
- b) To COMMIT to INTENTIONALLY pour into your students: IE.
 - Call, text, skype
 - ii. Visit students at work, school play, sporting event, family gathering etc.
 - iii. **Wish Happy Birthday**
 - iv. Invite over for a movie night, go see a movie, potluck etc.
- c) Introduce yourself and keep in contact with the parents of your students
- d) Attend ALL Youth Events (unless previously notified)
 - Fall Retreat in September i.
 - ii. **Leader Retreat in October**
 - iii.
 - Winter Retreat (Muskoka Woods) in January

 - **Summer Events**
- e) FULFILL commitment to Youth
 - A full year commitment is required: September September
- Be PREPARED for Small Group each week
 - Read the leader emails, prepare beforehand
- g) ABSOLUTELY NO ROMANTIC RÉLATIONSHIPS WITH STUDENTS (this will result in immediate dismissal and potential further disciplinary action)

EXPECTATIONS OUTSIDE THE YOUTH MINISTRY:

- a) Committed to grow in your relationship with Jesus Christ, and committed to be challenged and encouraged to be pushed in your faith
- b) Have regular attendance at Church (Harvest Bible Chapel)
- c) Refrain from the consumption of alcohol in public places (ie. Restaurants, bars etc..).
